ORDINANCE NO. 8202

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$40,553 to the Emergency Medical Services Fund from donated revenues for procurement of paramedic training, paramedic vehicle repair, program evaluation, and research-related capital equipment; and amending Ordinance 7864, Section 53, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$40,553 to the Emergency Medical Services Fund from donated revenues for procurement of paramedic training, paramedic vehicle repair, program evaluation, and research-related capital equipment.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 7864, Section 53, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

Emergency Medical Services - From the Emergency Medical Service Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Emergency Medical Services \$40,553

Provided that:

The executive present a program plan to the council by October 15, 1987 for evaluating a personal emergency response system (PERS) serving low income elderly persons inside the South King County Medic One Program Service Area.
