AN ORDINANCE approving the boundaries of the East King County Critical Water Supply Service Area.

PREAMBLE:

On December 22, 1986, the King County council passed Ordinance 7983, which designated East King County a Critical Water Supply Area.

On December 22, 1986, the King County council passed Ordinance 7894, establishing the East King County Water Utility Coordinating Committee (WUCC). Section 3(b) required the committee to develop and recommend external critical water supply service area boundaries to the King County council per WAC 248-56-600.

On June 11, 1987, East King County WUCC met and recommended the external critical boundaries.

On June 25, 1987, the East King County WUCC conducted an informational meeting on the East King County Critical Water Supply Plan external boundaries per WAC 248-56-600(2).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The external boundaries of the East King County Coordinated Water System Plan shall be as shown on Attachment A (East King County Regional Water Plan Study Area Map).
