- 3. The division of building and land development has reviewed the subject road vacation request and does not object to it, provided legal access is shown or established for the future development of abutting Lot 15 (tax lot 42460-0065). King County is now in receipt of an easement from Davco, a limited partnership, for the required 30 feet of access for Lot 15.
- 4. Kent-Kangley Road, adjacent to the petitioner's property, is a primary arterial road and requires 20 additional feet of right-of-way along the north side of that corridor. The department of public works recommends the roadway vacation be made conditional on the petitioner dedicating the needed right-of-way for this road. King County is now in receipt of a Warranty Deed from Davco, a limited partnership, for the required 20 additional feet of right-of-way for this roadway.
- 5. The vacation area is a portion of the plat of Lake Wilderness 5 Acre Tracts, recorded in Volume 20, page 27, records of King County, Washington. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 6. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
