ORDINANCE NO. 8227

AN ORDINANCE adopting the design of the Official King County Flag.

PREAMBLE:

Henry Paulman, a citizen of King County has on his own initiative, developed a design for an Official King County Flag and has had a prototype made at no expense to the county.

The King County Council recognizes and appreciates Mr. Paulman's efforts and looks forward to the display of the Official King County Flag at ceremonial and other occasions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The official King County flag shall consist of the county logo of a gold crown and encircling double gold rings on a rectangular green background.
