ORDINANCE NO. 8265

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Military Road/South 268th (Catholic Archdiocese) to Federal Way Water and Sewer District, for sewer service only.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Military Road/South 268th (Catholic Archdiocese) to Federal Way Water and Sewer District was filed with the county council effective September 25, 1987.

2. Federal Way Water and Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 87-152 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Federal Way Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated September 11, 1987, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 19th day of October, 1987 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Federal Way Water and Sewer District of the area known as Military Road/South 268th (Catholic Archdiocese) and described in Section 4 herein is approved for sewer service only. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Military Road/South 268th (Catholic Archdiocese).

SECTION 2. The Federal Way Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

1 SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute
2 county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises,
3 certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this
4 annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area
5 not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County
6 Sewerage General Plan.

7 SECTION 4. The area known as Military Road/South 268th
8 (Catholic Archdiocese) to be annexed is described as follows:

9 In Section 28, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., situatee
10 in King County, Washington,

11 Southeast 1/4 of Northeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 less County
12 road, less State highway.
