ORDINANCE NO. 8268

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$15,000 from Special Programs, Executive Contingency, to the City of Snoqualmie in order to help defray the costs of a consultant study preparing the city's 1988 budget, and amending Ordinance 7864, Section 35, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

FINDINGS:

The county council finds that the City of Snoqualmie has incurred public debt as a result of multi-faceted and interrelated economic and planning problems that are not duplicated elsewhere in King County, and

The council also finds that recent losses associated with flood damage require that the City of Snoqualmie immediately develop and institute administrative procedures and decision-making mechanisms which enable the city to solve this problem.

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$15,000 from Special Programs, Executive Contingency, to the City of Snoqualmie to help defray the cost of the consultant hired to prepare a 1988 budget.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 7864, Section 35, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs \$15,000
