

ORDINANCE NO. 18285

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of the Plat of Hollywood Acres.

Petitioner: King County Department of Public Works and Others, V-1935.

1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of the Plat of Hollywood Acres, hereinafter described.

2. The department of public Works requests the vacation of Lots 32, 33 and 34 of the Plat of Hollywood Acres on behalf of the King County Agriculture Program, which has purchased the development rights to the described properties. A vacation ordinance will consolidate the divided properties.

3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and does not anticipate any easements being required, as no right of way areas are being vacated.

4. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.

5. The vacation is classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 26th day of October, 1987.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 26th day of October, 1987, hereby vacates and abandons the following described portion of the Plat of Hollywood Acres:

Lots 32, 33 and 34 of Hollywood Acres, as recorded in Volume 29 of Plats, pages 23 and 24, records of King County, Washington.

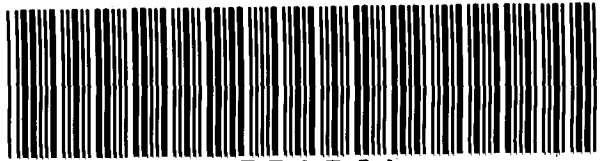
