AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Plat of Holyrood Cemetery West Petitioner: Corporation of the Catholic Archbishop of Seattle and Others V-1903

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- l. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of the Plat of Holyrood Cemetery West, hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are required by Seattle City Light. Seattle City Light has agreed to wait and acquire these easements after ownership has changed hands.
- 3. Washington State Department of Transportation has notified King County that they "desire this vacation to be subject to protection of existing utilities and the slope and drainage easement." In addition, Washington State Department of Transportation has indicated a need for additional right of way for SR 104 from the petitioners. The State of Washington is now in receipt of a Quit Claim Deed from the petitioners for the additional right of way for SR 104.
- 4. The building and land development division has studied the proposed plat vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 5. The vacation area was platted for cemetery purposes in Volume 92 of plats, page 28/30. This vacation does not involve any public right of way. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The plat is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 264 day of October ,1987, hereby vacates and abandons the following described portion of the Plat of Holyrood Cemetery West:

That portion of the Plat of Holyrood Cemetery West recorded in Volume 92 of Plats, page 28/30, described as being the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 5, Township 26 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington; EXCEPT portions thereof for Meridian Avenue North, First Avenue N.E., North 195th Street and North 205th Street.
