ORDINANCE NO.

SECTION 1. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise requires, the terms defined in this section shall, for all purposes of this ordinance and of any ordinance supplemental hereto, have the meanings specific; words importing the singular number include the plural number and vice versa:

"County" means King County, Washington.

"Council" means the county council of King County, Washington.

"Community Development (CD) Interim Financing" shall mean the making of short term interim financing loans to assist in the development of Community Development Block Grant eligible projects.

"Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds" shall be those entitlement monies King County receives through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and are dedicated to the CDBG fund.

## SECTION 2. It is found and determined:

- A. The prevention of child abuse and the treatment of abused and neglected children is a priority of the King County council,
- B. The prevention of child abuse and neglect is of critical importance to the children and families who benefit from day care, counseling and therapy services,

C. Society as a whole benefits significantly from a reduction in the abuse and neglect of children,

D. Childhaven Inc. has a long history and excellent record of providing services to abused and neglected children, Childhaven Inc. has recently constructed the Eli Creekmore day care and counseling facility in the White Center area, eighty percent of Childhaven's clients are at or below subsistence income levels.

SECTION 3. King County finds it is in the best interests of the county to make a CD Interim Loan to Childhaven Inc. The loan will be used for the refinance of the Eli Creekmore Day Care Center which will provide services with primary benefit to lower income persons and enhance the CDBG fund by earning interest for CDBG eligible activities.

SECTION 4. In accordance with regulations of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development the King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into a CD Interim Loan to Childhaven Inc. such unexpended balances as may become available in the King County CDBG Letter of Credit on deposit with the United States Department of the Treasury in an amount not to exceed eight hundred thirty thousand dollars for use in development of the Eli Creekmore Day Care Center project. The loan shall be repaid to King County in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement between Childhaven Inc. and King County. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute the above referenced agreements on behalf of the county.

SECTION 5. For the purpose of making this CD Interim Loan the sum of eight hundred thirty thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund the Eli Creekmore Day Care Center shall be disbursed from the King County CDBG Letter of Credit on deposit with the United States Department of the Treasury.
