- The petition for vacation does not contain the signatures of all abutting property owners. The owner of Tax Lot 0005, who owns 8 feet of land adjoining the West end of the platted alley, has chosen not to sign the petition. His share represents 2 percent of the alley boundary lines. All of the other adjoining landowners have signed and paid to have this alley vacated.
- A search of the records indicates that no public funds been expended for its acquisition, improvement or The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in maintenance. accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
