- 4. A field check of the site reveals the probability of building structures being located on the right of way. In addition, it was noted that the roadway was paved at some time after its dedication. In accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "B Class."
- 5. The department of public works recommends that the subject road vacation be granted subject to the petitioner's providing the following:
  - 1. Recorded easement agreements that protect all abutting owners for ingress, egress and utilities.
  - 2. Deeds to King County for 12 additional feet of right of way for 244th Avenue Southeast.

Provisions of these stipulated items have been met and should resolve the concerns of the building and land development division and planning division. The department of public works will deem the exchange of the vacation for the stipulated items mutually beneficial to all parties.
