AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation to the City of Redmond of an area known as 134th Avenue Northeast and declaring an emergency.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- The City Council of the Redmond, Washington, by Resolution No. 759 has resolved that the best interest, and general welfare of the City of Redmond would be served by the annexation of contiguous unincorporated territory known as 134th Avenue Northeast as hereafter described in accordance with R.C.W. 35.14.015
- 2. Said resolution does satisfy the provisions of Chapter 35.13. R.C.W. for qualification for annexation by election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 15th day of March, 1988, in accordance with R.C.W. 35.13.070 within the territory of the proposed annexation as herein described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within said territory, the question of annexation to the City of Redmond.

SECTION 2. The number of registered voters within the subject area is approximately  $\underline{67}$  as nearly as may be determined from available records.

SECTION 3. The boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation are hereby described as follows:

That portion of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 10, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; situate in the County of King, State of Washington; described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of said subdivision which is 332.79 feet southerly from the northwest corner thereof;

Thence easterly S 88-54-30 E a distance of 30 feet to the true point of beginning of the tract of land herein described;

Thence continuing easterly S 88-54-30 E 140 feet more or less to the western boundary of the City of Redmond Incorporated by ordinance number 431;

Thence southerly S 01-26-30 W 166.84 feet more or less along the western boundary of the City of Redmond, to the southern boundary of the City of Redmond as incorporated by said ordinance number 431;

Thence easterly S 88-54-30 E 158.95 more or less along the southern boundary of the City of redmond as incorporated by said ordinance number 431, to the east boundary of the City of Redmond as incorporated by ordinance number 431;

Thence southerly S 01-27-07 W 728.74 feet more or less along the western boundary of the City of Redmond as incorporated by said ordinance number 1007, to the northerly margin of N.E. 75th St. and the northern boundary of the City of Redmond as incorporated by Ordinance No. 1007;

Thence westerly N 88-38-51 W 300.85 feet more or less along the northern boundary of the City of Redmond as incorporated by said ordinance number 1007, to the western boundary of the City of Redmond as incorporated by ordinance number 1007;
