ORDINANCE NO. 8387

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Duvall
1987 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On July 23, 1987, the City of Duvall completed a
Declaration of Non-significance to comply with the State
Environmental Policy Act (for their water plan).

On July 23, 1987, the City of Duvall Council passed
Resolution 278 adopting their 1987 Comprehensive Water
Plan.

On September 17, 1987, the City of Duvall submitted their
1987 Comprehensive Water System Plan to King County
pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On October 20, 1987, the Utilities Technical Review
Committee met and recommended approval of the City of
Duvall 1987 Comprehensive Water System Plan with a
condition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Duvall 1987 Comprehensive Water
System Plan adopted by the City of Duvall Resolution 278 is
hereby approved, with the following condition:

Land development south of the Tolt Supply Pipeline shall
be consistent with the county's Land Use Plans.
