ORDINANCE NO. 8411

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as DS 87-1 to Des Moines Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as DS 87-1 to Des Moines Sewer District was filed with the county council effective December 24, 1987.

2. Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 1987-24 concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. Des Moines Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated November 11, 1987, on the proposed annexation.

4. The county council held a public hearing on the 1st day of February, 1988 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Des Moines Sewer District of the area known as DS 87-1 and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on DS 87-1.

SECTION 2. The Des Moines Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.

1            SECTION 4. The area known as DS 87-1 to be annexed is  
2 described as follows:

4            That portion of the East 1/2 of section 5, Township 22 North,  
5 Range 4 East, W.M., described as follows:

6            Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Des Moines  
7 Way with the centerline of South 196th Place;

8            Thence Easterly along said centerline of South 196th Place to  
9 its intersection with a line which is 137.5 feet Easterly of  
10 and parallel with the centerline of 13th Avenue South;

11           Thence Southerly along said parallel line to its intersection  
12 with a line which is 130 feet Northerly of and parallel with  
13 the centerline of South 199th Street;

14           Thence Easterly along said parallel line 137.5 feet more or  
15 less to its intersection with the centerline of vacated 14th  
16 Avenue South;

17           Thence Southerly along said centerline to its intersection  
18 with the centerline of South 200th Street;

19           Thence Easterly along said centerline to its intersection with  
20 the centerline of 15th Avenue South;

21           Thence Southerly along said centerline to its intersection  
22 with the centerline of South 201st street;

23           Thence Easterly along said centerline to its intersection with  
24 a line which is 137.5 feet Easterly of and parallel with the  
25 centerline of 15th Avenue South;

26           Thence Southerly along said parallel line to its intersection  
27 with the centerline of South 207th Street;

28           Thence Westerly along said centerline to its intersection with  
29 the centerline of (PADDOCK AVENUE) 12th Avenue South;

30           Thence Northerly along said centerline to its intersection  
31 with the centerline of South 207th Street;

32           Thence Westerly along said centerline to its intersection with  
33 the centerline of Des Moines Way;

1 Thence Northerly along said centerline to its intersection  
2 with the centerline of South 196th Place and the Point of  
Beginning.
