ORDINANCE NO 8470

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Bellevue 1987 Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On September 9, 1987, the City of Bellevue completed a Determination of significance for their sewer plan.

On September 29, 1987, the City of Bellevue issued a Notice of Adoption of the necessary documents addressing the significant impacts of the proposal.

On February 1, 1988, the City of Bellevue Council passed Resolution 4972 adopting their 1987 Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On February 2, 1988, the City of Bellevue submitted their 1987 Comprehensive Sewer Plan to King County pursuant to K.C.C. 13.24.

On March 1, 1988, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met and recommended approval of the City of Bellevue 1987 Comprehensive Sewer Plan with a condition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Bellevue 1987 Comprehensive Sewer Plan adopted by the City of Bellevue Resolution 4972 is hereby approved, with the following condition:

Utilities Technical Review Committee action does not indicate approval of sewer jurisdiction lines, especially as they pertain to the North Village.
