ORDINANCE NO8471

AN ORDINANCE adopting the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner with regard to the speed limit on the Issaquah/Hobart Road.

PREAMBLE:

On October 19, 1987, the King County council passed Ordinance 8283, directing the zoning and subdivision examiner to hold a hearing on an appeal of the decision of the director of public works to reduce the speed limit on the Issaquah/Hobart Road.

Mirrormont Blvd. to the Issaquah city limits and to undertake other mitigating measures as spelled out in the examiner's report are hereby adopted by the council of King County.
