ORDINANCE NO. **8478**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing publication and distribution of a voters' pamphlet; amending Ordinance 8113, Sections 1, 2 and 9, and K.C.C. 1.10.010, 1.10.020 and 1.10.070.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 8113, Section 1 and K.C.C. 1.10.010 are hereby amended as follows:

Publication and Distribution. Publication and distribution of a local voter's pamphlet in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW, for annual general elections held in King County, and for primary and special elections as determined by the council, is hereby authorized. Said pamphlet shall ((be published-for-the-November-1987-general-election-and-may-be published-for-each-primary,-general,-or-special-election thereafter-to)) include:

A. All King County candidates and measures.

B. Cities, towns, or special taxing districts located wholly within King County, which have indicated in writing that the jurisdiction's legislative authority has chosen to participate.

C. Cities, towns, or special taxing districts located within King County and another county, if the counties have entered into a distribution agreement pursuant to RCW 29.81A.020(1) and if the jurisdiction's legislative authority has chosen to participate.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 8113, Section 2 and K.C.C. 1.10.020 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Notification. ((A--Within-five-days-of-the-effective-date of-this-chapter,-the-division-of-records-and-elections-shall notify-each-city,-town,-or-special-taxing-district-located-wholly

3 B.)) Prior to any ((subsequent)) primary, general, or  
4 special election for which a voter's pamphlet is being prepared,  
5 the King County records and elections division shall notify each  
6 city, town, and special taxing district located wholly within  
7 King County ((in-the-event)) that a local voter's pamphlet will  
8 be published and distributed.

9 SECTION 3. Ordinance 8113, Section 9 and K.C.C. 1.10.070 are  
10 each hereby amended to read as follows:

11 Evaluation report and authorization.

12 ((A.--By-January-5,-1988,)) Each January following a year in  
13 which a voter's pamphlet is produced, the executive shall submit  
14 a report to the council evaluating the division of records and  
15 elections' experience in producing the ((November-1987)) voters'  
16 pamphlet. The report shall include a statement of overall costs  
17 and costs to participating jurisdictions, level of local  
18 participation, impacts on election turnout, reception of the  
19 pamphlet by voters and participants and any other information  
20 necessary to an analysis of the program by the council.
