ORDINANCE NO. **8494**

An Ordinance increasing the appropriation in CIP Project Number 200588 by \$909,544 for Issaquah-Hobart Road intersection improvements and reducing the appropriation for CIP Project Number 200490 by \$909,544 for Issaquah-Hobart Road shoulder improvements, and amending Ordinance 8331, Sections 80 and 81.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$909,544 in CIP Project Number 200588, to provide intersection improvements along Issaquah-Hobart Road between Southeast May Valley Road and Southeast 156th Street.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted a cancellation of \$909,544 for Issaquah-Hobart Road shoulder improvements, CIP Project No. 200490.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 8331, Section 80 as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amount for the specific project identified in Section 1 of this ordinance:

SECTION 4. Ordinance 8331, Section 81 as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting the following:

Additional accumulated unexpended prior years' appropriations from several capital improvement project funds for the specific project listed in Section 2 are hereby canceled as follows:
