AN ORDINANCE establishing a donation or gift trust account for the King County centennial commission and governing the expenditure of such funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Definitions.

- A. "Centennial" means King County's involvement in the Washington State Centennial Celebration as set forth in Ordinance No. 7524.
 - B. "Commission" means the King County centennial commission.
- C. "Donor" means a private or nonprofit organization or individual who gives monies or in-kind donations to the commission to be used for the purposes authorized in this ordinance or Ordinance No. 7524.
- D. "Program" means an activity or event to carry out the intent of the Washington State Centennial Celebration.
- E. "Project" means a proposal or plan which will result in a final product.
- F. "Department Director" means the director of the parks, planing and resources department or assigned designee.

SECTION 2. Centennial Trust Account.

A. The commission may seek and accept gifts, bequests, and donations from any source to support, promote, encourage, and foster the centennial celebration within the county.

B. All monetary gifts, bequests, or donations received by the commission, including those given for general usage by the commission, shall be deposited by the commission into the centennial trust account, as hereafter created by the office of inancial management, finance division. No general operating unds, grant monies, or funds received from other source other than those specified in this section shall be deposited into the centennial trust account.

C. The department director shall assure that all monies teposited in the centennial account are expended in conformance with state and county laws and commission rules.

SECTION 3. Allocation of Commission Funds.

A. Procedures.

- 1. Subject to approval by council finance committee, the commission is authorized to award funds from the Centennial Trust Account for centennial programs or projects.
- 2. The commission shall establish rules and regulations governing procedures whereby a person or organization may apply for money pursuant to this section. Such rules shall be filed as art of the rules of the commission, adopted pursuant to Section 6.A. of Ordinance No. 8300. Distribution of awards shall be made in accordance with funding criteria developed by the commission and filed as part of their rules under Section 67.A., Ordinance to 8300, and by the guidelines established in this ordinance.
- B. Appeals. The commission shall specify, in the rules adopted pursuant to Section 6.A. of Ordinance No. 8300, the rocess by which commission funding allocation decisions may be appealed.

Gifts of Personal or Real Property. SECTION 4. commission is hereby authorized to accept, at its discretion, gifts of money and/or personal property up to amounts of \$5,000for the purpose of promoting, encouraging, and fostering the centennial celebration within King County. Any gift of money or personal property of a value greater than \$5,000 shall be subject to provisions of K.C.C. 2.80.010. This authority shall expire on December 31, 1989, unless otherwise extended. SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this chapter or the operation of such provision should be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions of this chapter or their operation unless dependent for their effect or operation upon the provision held invalid, and then only to the extent of such dependency and for such purpose the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.
