An Ordinance appropriating \$433,149 to the Evergreen Pool CIP Project No. 010070, \$281,456 to the Shoreline Pool CIP Project No. 010078, and \$65,650 to the Pool Asbestos Abatement CIP Project No. 010133 in the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund (349) supported by transfers of \$193,000 from the Mt. Rainier Pool CIP Project No. 010050 in the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund, and \$92,863 from the Grandview Park CIP Project No. 070303, and \$494,392 from the REET Fund balance for the purposes of asbestos abatement and assessment, amending Ordinance No. 8331, Section 60 and Section 80, Attachments No. 1 and 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$433,149 to the Evergreen Pool CIP Project No. 010070 in the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund from unappropriated fund balance in the same fund for asbestos abatement and related rehabilitation.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$281,456 to the Shoreline Pool CIP Project No. 010078 in the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund from unappropriated fund balance in the same fund for asbestos abatement and related rehabilitation.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$65,650 to the Pool Asbestos Assessment CIP Project No. 010133 in the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund from unappropriated fund balance in the same fund for assessment for asbestos abatement efforts required in the County pool system.

SECTION 4. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of \$92,863 from the Grandview Park CIP Project No. 070303, and a transfer of \$494,392 from Real Estate Excise Tax Fund balance appropriating a total of \$587,255 to the Transfer to Fund 349 CIP Project No. 010106 in the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Fund (315).

SECTION 5. There is hereby approved and adopted a transfer of \$193,000 from the Mt. Rainier Pool CIP Project No. 010050 to the Evergreen Pool CIP Project No. 010070 in the Parks Facilities Rehabilitation Fund for asbestos abatement and related rehabilitation purposes.

SECTION 6. Ordinance 8331, Section 60, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
