ORDINANCE NO 8581

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$271,409 to several CIP projects in the Surface and Stormwater Management Construction Fund, and \$23,698 to several projects in the Hydraulics Construction Fund from a transfer of \$324,462 from several project cancellations in the Surface and Stormwater Construction Fund, amending Ordinance No. 8331, Section 80, Attachments No. 1 and 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$271,409 in the Surface and Stormwater Management Construction Fund for McAleer Multipurpose Pond, CIP project No. 047005 in the amount of \$91,005; for Madsen Creek Channel Improvements, CIP project No. 047021 in the amount of \$12,549; for Peterson Regional Pond, CIP project No. 047013 in the amount of \$151,951; for the N.E. 124th Street Sedimentation Basin, CIP project No. 047046 in the amount of \$11,603; for 229th Place N.E. Drainage, CIP No. 047038 in the amount of \$4,247; for the N.E. 124th R/D Pond, CIP project No. 047011 in the amount of \$33; for R/D Pond No. 0701, CIP project No. 047012 in the amount of \$8; and for R/D Pond No. 1003, CIP project No. 047014 in the amount of \$13, from a transfer of funds from project cancellations.

SECTION 2. There is hereby adopted an appropriation of \$23,698 in the Hydraulics Construction Fund for the Little Bear Creek Drainage Facility, CIP project No. 046293 in the amount of \$23,271; for the West Lake Sammamish FCZD CIP project No. 044872 in the amount of \$221; for the Boeing Creek-Hidden Lake Drainage Facility, CIP project No. 045231 in the amount of \$110; for Segal

Revetment, CIP project No. 045256 in the amount of \$13; for the First Avenue South Drainage Facility, CIP project No. 046286 in the amount of \$75; and for the N.E. 124th Sedimentation Basin Design, CIP project No. 046292 in the amount of \$8 from a transfer of funds from project cancellations.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved a cancellation of \$324,462 from Inglemoor High School Channel, CIP project No. 047050 in the amount of \$28,000; from the Louis Thompson Road Stabilization, CIP project No. 047052 in the amount of \$17,200; from Pipeline 85-87, CIP project No. 047051 in the amount of \$39,000; from Cemetary Regional Wetland, CIP project No. 047016 in the amount of \$55,455; from the S.E. 24th St. Drainage Facility, CIP project No. 047015 in the amount of \$131,555; and from "Opportunity Project" CIP project No. 047043 in the amount of \$53,252 to provide the necessary transfers for the projects identified in Sections 1 and 2 above.

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 8331, Section 80, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
