ORDINANCE NO. 8608

An Ordinance appropriating funds in the amount of \$50,000 to the Surface Water Management Division from the River Improvement Fund unencumbered fund balance to fund King County's portion of an Army Corps of Engineers flood control on the Cedar River, and amending Ordinance No. 8331, Section 51, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$50,000 to the surface water management division from the River Improvement Fund unencumbered fund balance to provide King County's share of an Army Corps of Engineers study to evaluate alternative flood control operating plans for the City of Seattle's Masonry Dam on the Cedar River.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8331, Section 51 is hereby amended to read as follows:

RIVER IMPROVEMENTS - From the River Improvement Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

River Improvements \$50,000
