ORDINANCE NO. 8636

AN ORDINANCE relating to the minimum wages to be paid by King County to its employees and by businesses contracting with King County to provide goods or service.

PREAMBLE:

King County council finds the public interest and basic economic justice requires that individuals who work for a living should be entitled to make a decent wage. King Co King County council finds the present State minimum wage law does not accomplish this end. As a matter of public policy it believes that its own employees as well as the employees of those who contract with the county must be paid more than the present State minimum wage. The council hereby concludes that it must take action now.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. No employee of King County working full-time, part-time or temporary shall be paid at any rate of less than \$3.85 per hour until January 1, 1990 nor less than \$4.25 after that date.

SECTION 2. No contractor or subcontractor doing business with King County or furnishing workers or services in connection thereof shall pay any employee performing any work for such business with King County less than \$3.85 per hour up to January 1, 1990 and \$4.25 per hour thereafter.
