4 AN ORDINANCE relating to a proposed amendment
5 of Article 3, Section 350.20.20, King County
6 Charter, concerning the administration of the
7 department of judicial administration by the
8 superior court clerk, submitting the same to
9 the voters of the county and establishing a
10 date of election.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

12 SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters
13 of King County for their approval and ratification or rejection,
14 at the next general election to be held in this county, an
15 amendment to Article 3, Section 350.20.20 of the King County
16 Charter to read as follows:

17 Department of Judicial Administration.

18 The department of judicial administration shall be
19 administered by the superior court clerk who shall be appointed by
20 (~~the county executive from a list of three or more nominees~~
21 ~~submitted by~~) and serve at the pleasure of a majority of the
22 superior court judges in the county. The department of judicial
23 administration shall maintain the official court files, records
24 and indexes necessary for the efficient administration of justice
25 and the court system and shall perform such other duties assigned
26 to it by a majority of the superior court judges in the county.

27 The department of judicial administration shall be an
28 executive department subject to the personnel system and shall
29 utilize the services of the administrative offices and the
30 executive departments, but it shall not be abolished by the county
31 council.

1 SECTION 2. The manager of the division of records and
2 elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the King
3 County charter to be published in accordance with the State
4 Constitution and general law and placed upon the ballot at the
5 next general election on November 8, 1988.
