ORDINANCE NO. 8651

AN ORDINANCE relating to a proposed amendment of Article 5, Section 550, King County Charter, concerning career service and exempt positions, submitting same to the voters of the county and establishing a date of election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters of King County for their approval and ratification or rejection, at the next general election to be held in this county, an amendment to Article 5, section 550 of the King County Charter to read as follows:

Career Service Positions.

All county employees and officers shall be members of the career service except those in the following positions; all elected officers; the county auditor; the clerk and all other employees of the county council; the county administrative officer; the chief officer of each executive department and administrative office; the members of all boards and commissions; administrative assistants for the county executive and one administrative assistant each for the county administrative officer, the county auditor, the county assessor, the chief officer of each executive department and administrative office, and for each board and commission; a chief deputy for the county assessor; one confidential secretary each for the county executive, the chief officer of each executive department and administative office, and for each administrative assistant specified herein; all employees of those officers who are exempted from the provisions of this charter by the state

constitution; persons employed in a professional or scientific capacity to conduct a special inquiry, investigation or examination; ((part-time-and)) temporary employees; administrative interns; election precinct officials; all persons serving the county without compensation; physicians; surgeons; dentists; medical interns; and student nurses and inmates employed by county hospitals, tuberculosis sanitariums and health departments of the county. Part-time Employees. All part-time employees shall be exempted from career service membership except, effective January 1, 1989, all part-time employees employed at least half-time or more, as defined by ordinance, shall be members of the career service. SECTION 2. The manager of the division of records and elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the King County charter to be published in accordance with the State Constitution and general law and placed upon the ballot at the next general election on November 8, 1988.
