3 ORDINANCE NO. **8651**

4 AN ORDINANCE relating to a proposed
5 amendment of Article 5, Section 550, King
6 County Charter, concerning career service
7 and exempt positions, submitting same to
8 the voters of the county and establishing
9 a date of election.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters
12 of King County for their approval and ratification or rejection,
13 at the next general election to be held in this county, an
14 amendment to Article 5, section 550 of the King County Charter to
15 read as follows:

16 Career Service Positions.

17 All county employees and officers shall be members of the
18 career service except those in the following positions; all
19 elected officers; the county auditor; the clerk and all other
20 employees of the county council; the county administrative
21 officer; the chief officer of each executive department and
22 administrative office; the members of all boards and commissions;
23 administrative assistants for the county executive and one
24 administrative assistant each for the county administrative
25 officer, the county auditor, the county assessor, the chief
26 officer of each executive department and administrative office,
27 and for each board and commission; a chief deputy for the county
28 assessor; one confidential secretary each for the county
29 executive, the chief officer of each executive department and
30 administrative office, and for each administrative assistant
31 specified herein; all employees of those officers who are
32 exempted from the provisions of this charter by the state

1 constitution; persons employed in a professional or scientific
2 capacity to conduct a special inquiry, investigation or
3 examination; ((part-time-and)) temporary employees;
4 administrative interns; election precinct officials; all persons
5 serving the county without compensation; physicians; surgeons;
6 dentists; medical interns; and student nurses and inmates
7 employed by county hospitals, tuberculosis sanitariums and health
8 departments of the county.

9 Part-time Employees. All part-time employees shall be
10 exempted from career service membership except, effective January
11 1, 1989, all part-time employees employed at least half-time or
12 more, as defined by ordinance, shall be members of the career
13 service.

14 SECTION 2. The manager of the division of records and
15 elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the
16 King County charter to be published in accordance with the State
17 Constitution and general law and placed upon the ballot at the
18 next general election on November 8, 1988.

20 of August, 1988.
