ORDINANCE NO. 8680

AN ORDINANCE permitting King County to enter into a five year lease agreement for the Issaquah District Court Facility and authorizing payment of the lease rental.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with the provision of K.C.C. 4.04.040, the King County Council may adopt an ordinance permitting the county to enter into contracts requiring the payment of funds from the appropriation of subsequent fiscal years. It is proposed to enter into a five year lease agreement for the continued operation of the Issaquah District Court Facility. It has been determined that the lease rate is at terms favorable to and in the best interests of the people of King County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute a five year lease agreement for 7,540 square feet of gross space located at 640 N.W. Gilman Blvd., Issaquah, Washington for an initial rental of \$7,500 per month, full serviced. The lease agreement shall provide for the Issaquah District Court's exclusive use of thirty-five parking stalls, a number of stalls that the Issaguah District Court judge advises will be sufficient for court purposes during the term of the lease agreement. The rental rate shall be \$11.87 per square foot per year for the first two years, increasing to \$15.00 per square foot for the final three years of the agreement. King County will have an option to extend this agreement for an additional It will also have an option to purchase the entire five years. facility.
