AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 34th Avenue South V-1980 Petitioner: Sabey Corporation and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 34th Avenue South, hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and has no objection to the vacation of 34th Avenue South, provided the platted lots it was designed to serve (i.e., Lots 1-8, Block 5, Plat of Riverton and Lots 25-32, Block 6, Plat of Riverton) are also vacated.
- 4. The building and land development division finds that South 125th Street requires 30 additional feet of right of way in the vicinity of the petitioner's property. A rezone request for the immediate area was scheduled for March 1, 1988. King County is now in receipt of a deed for the additional 30 feet that is the requirement for the rezone.
- 5. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
