6 AN ORDINANCE creating SR 520/SR 202 CIP Project No. 100889;
7 appropriating \$223,000 from the Bridge Replacement Fund 125
8 and appropriating \$27,000 of developer mitigation fees to the
9 SR 520/SR 202 Intersection CIP Project and amending
10 Ordinance No. 8331, Section 80 as amended.

11 FINDINGS:

12 The level of service (LOS) at the intersection of SR 520 and SR 202 is
13 unacceptable according to King County road adequacy standards. King County
14 and the City of Redmond are reserving developer mitigation payments for
15 improvements to the intersection. The project was part of the county legisla-
16 tive program in 1988, along with the First Avenue South Bridge. Although the
17 project is a high priority project for the State of Washington, funding has
18 not been made available. An extraordinary effort by King County to fund pre-
19 liminary design of the project is necessary to generate state funding for the
20 construction of improvements.

21 SECTION 1. There is hereby created a new roads CIP Project (No. 100889)
22 entitled the SR 520/SR 202 Intersection CIP Project.

23 SECTION 2. There is hereby approved an appropriation in the Bridge
24 Replacement Fund 125 of \$223,000 to "Transfer to Fund 386", for the SR 520/SR
25 202 Intersection CIP Project.

26 SECTION 3. There is hereby approved an appropriation of \$27,000 in devel-
27 oper mitigation fees in the County Road Construction Fund 386 for the SR
28 520/SR 202 intersection CIP project.

29 SECTION 4. Ordinance 8331, Section 80 as amended, is hereby amended by
30 adding thereto and inserting the following:

31 From the several capital improvement funds there is hereby appropriated
32 and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects
33 identified in Attachment No. 1, as adjusted by Attachment No. 2, of this
ordinance.
