4 ORDINANCE NO **8750**

6 AN ORDINANCE relating to revenue sources, raising fees for
7 department of public safety records and services, amending
8 Section 1, Ordinance 6598, as amended, and KCC 2.12.110.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. KCC 2.12.110 and Section 1, Ordinance 6598, as amended, are
11 hereby amended to read as follows:

12 Copy fees. A. OFFICIAL RECORDS. Charges for copies of official
13 records shall be in accordance with fees set forth in applicable chapters of
14 the RCW.

15 B. PUBLIC RECORDS.

16 1. Certified Copies. Eight and one-half inches by fourteen inches or
17 smaller for the first page two dollars and for each additional page one
18 dollar.

19 2. NONCERTIFIED COPIES.

20 a. Class I: Eight and one-half inches by fourteen inches or smaller
21 copies produced on Xerox, dry film printer or other similar copy machine
22 determined by the manager of the records and elections division to have
23 roughly equivalent costs; for the first page fifty cents; for each additional
24 page twenty-five cents;

25 b. Class II: Eight and one-half inches by fourteen inches or
26 smaller copies produced on photostat or similar machine determined by the man-
27 ager of the records and election division to have roughly equivalent costs;
28 for the first page two dollars; for each additional page one dollar;

29 c. Class III: Diazo duplicates of microfiche; for the first fiche
30 fifty cents; for each additional fiche twenty-five cents;

31 d. Class IV: Opaque ozalid process or similar copies determined by
32 the manager of the records and election division to have equivalent costs;

1 fifty cents per running foot or fraction up to forty-two inches wide;

2 e. Class V: In cases where the manager of the records and election
3 division deems self-service by the public to be feasible, a coinbox-operated
4 machine may be installed to provide copies at the lowest possible cost.

5 f. Class VI: Paper copies of microfilm records from roll film or
6 microfiche and produced by Bell and Howell, Kodak, 3-M or similar copy
7 processes; for the first page of each record, fifty cents; for each addi-
8 tional page, twenty-five cents;

9 g. Class VII: Bulk rates for multiple copies (in excess of ten to
10 twenty-five) and/or documents shall reflect actual costs.

11 h. Class VIII: Voter registration files.

12 (1) Printouts - \$125.00 base file processing charge plus:

13 (a) One-part paper - .35 per precinct

14 (b) Two-part paper - .50 per precinct

15 (c) Four-part paper - .65 per precinct

16 (2) Name and address labels - \$125.00 base file processing
17 charge plus:

18 \$1.75 per precinct (systems services supplied)

19 (3) Standard magnetic tape (1600 BPI minimum) - \$125.00 base
20 file processing charge plus:

21 .15 per precinct

22 (4) Certify tape - no base file processing charge plus:

23 \$10.00 per reel

24 (5) Systems services supplies magnetic tape

25 \$25.00 certified check per reel loaned

26 i. Class IX: Department of public safety:

27 Case Reports: - Six dollars per request for each report requested by members
28 of the public up to 20 pages, .25 for each additional page.

29 Records Checks: (~~Six~~) Ten dollars per request for each request by members
30 of the public.

1 Fingerprinting: Five dollars for an original card; two dollars for each
2 additional card for the same person.

3 NEW SECTION SECTION 2. If any portion of this ordinance or its applica-
4 tion to any person or set of circumstances should be held unconstitutional, it
5 shall not affect any other portion of this ordinance or other application to
6 other persons or sets of circumstances.
