3 ORDINANCE NO.

4 AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in county
5 owned parking facilities, establishing fees and
6 amending Ordinance No. 3511, Sections 4 and 5,
7 and K.C.C. 3.32.030 and 3.32.040; repealing
8 Ordinance No. 6599, Section 1 and K.C.C. 3.32.020
9 and substituting a new section; and adding new
10 sections.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

12 SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6599, Section 1, as amended and
13 K.C.C. 3.32.020 are hereby repealed and the following substituted:

14 Parking Fees - General. A. All county employees and elected
15 officials who are assigned the regular use of a parking stall
16 within any of the county-owned parking facilities shall pay
17 parking fees as provided in this chapter. Parking fees shall not
18 be paid by the county in behalf of any individual employee or
19 elected official who is assigned the regular use of a county
20 parking stall regardless of whose vehicle that person parks in
21 the stall. Current county employees covered by existing
22 collective bargaining agreements shall be affected only in a
23 manner consistent with state law.

24 B. Method of payment. Such parking fees shall be paid
25 through monthly payroll deductions from the wages of the employee
26 or elected official who is assigned the regular use of the county
27 parking stall regardless of whether that person is assigned the
28 use of a county owned vehicle, assigned a vehicle provided at
29 county expense, or uses a privately-owned vehicle.

30 C. Optional survey. The department of executive
31 administration may conduct a survey of the monthly parking rates
32 charged for public parking in lots of ten or more spaces within
33 the area bounded by Jackson Street on the south, Sixth Avenue on
the east, Columbia Street on the north and Second Avenue on the

1 west. Such survey and any parking fee recommendations shall be
2 forwarded to the council for consideration during the budget
3 process.

4 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3511, Section 4, and K.C.C.
5 3.32.030 are hereby amended to read as follows:

6 Exemptions. King County motor pool vehicles not assigned to
7 individuals are exempt from the provisions of Section 3.32.020
8 (~~provided that this exemption shall expire December 31, 1978,~~
9 ~~and the implementing plan to charge motor pool vehicles will~~
10 ~~be presented to the council by July 1, 1978~~)).

11 SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 3511, Section 5 and K.C.C. 3.32.040
12 are hereby amended to read as follows:

13 Public parking area. Parking spaces will be established for
14 public parking without charge to be used in connection with
15 county business. (~~Public~~) Said parking shall be limited to
16 two hours. Exceptions can be made if they meet
17 explicit criteria for exemptions established (~~by the King County~~
18 ~~administrative officer~~) in accordance with Section 3.32.010 and
19 monitored by the King County auditor.

20 NEW SECTION. SECTION 4. County automotive parking
21 facilities shall refer to the parking spaces found in the
22 following areas:

- 23 A. County automotive center, 5th and Jefferson.
24 B. County courthouse, 3rd and James.
25 C. County adult detention center, 5th and James.
26 D. Open surface lots located at 5th and Jefferson, and on
27 Yesler.

28 NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. Parking Rates - Parking stalls in
29 the King County automotive center, adult detention center and
30 courthouse. The basic monthly parking rate for parking stalls in
31 the county automotive center, adult detention center and
32 courthouse shall be as follows:

Effective Date	Covered Parking	Uncovered Parking
January 1, 1989	\$55.00	\$50.00

NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. Parking Rates - Surface Parking

Lots. The parking rates for daily parking in designated open surface parking lots shall be as follows:

A. General parking on county business which exceeds the two hour limit, general public not on county business, and county employees:

1. Effective January 1, 1989:

0- 2 hours \$3.00

2- 4 hours \$5.00

4-10 hours \$7.00

Special events \$6.00

2. Evenings after 6 p.m. and all day

Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays

except during special events. \$4.00

B. Special events rates - conditions. Special events rates shall apply after 6 pm weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays and shall apply during those events designated in accordance with Section 3.32.010. These rates shall not apply to county employees using county parking stalls while engaged in county business.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 7. Parking Fee Revenues -

Disposition. All revenues derived from parking fee rates shall be used to pay the operating expenses of county parking facilities and the bond retirement for the automotive center.

PROVIDED THAT:

All parking revenues derived from the increase of parking rates effective on or after January 1, 1989 shall be reserved for the support of health and human services activities and shall be deposited in the Health and Human Services Set-aside Fund.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the provisions of the county charter but no sooner than January 1, 1989.
