ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the organization of the executive branch of county government, establishing project manager positions of limited duration as exempt positions under the key subordinate unit provision, amending Ordinance 6066, Section 26 as amended and K.C.C. 2.16.100.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6066, Section 26 as amended and K.C.C. 2.16.100 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Career Service Exemptions.

- A. Exemptions from the requirements of the career service personnel system shall be consistent with the provisions of Section 550, and Sections 350.10 and 350.20 of the King County Charter. Key subordinate units, as determined by the county council, and departmental divisions shall be considered to be executive departments and divisions of the administrative office of financial management shall be considered to be administrative offices for the purpose of determining the applicability of the charter provisions.
- B. Accordingly, directors, managers and supervisors of departments, divisions, key subordinate units as determined by the county council, and other units of government as required by law, shall be exempt from the requirements and provisions of the career service personnel system.
- C. In this regard, the following are determined by the council to be key subordinate units due to the nature of the programs involved and their public policy implications, and appointments thereto shall be subject to confirmation by the council:
