AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 152nd Avenue N.E. Petitioner: Gregory and Suzanne Sorkness and Others V-1948; and amending Ordinance No. 8716.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 152nd Avenue N.E., hereinafter described.
- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement was granted to Woodinville Water District.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 6. Ordinance No. 8716 which previously approved this vacation as adopted failed to reflect the amendments recommended by the Transportation and Public Utilities Committee regarding reservation of an easement over the proposed vacation area, and therefore Ordinance No. 8716 was adopted in error.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 3/st day of 0,000, 1988.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
