ORDINANCE NO. 8821

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election to determine whether Woodinville shall be incorporated as a non-charter code city.

PREAMBLE:

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 35A.03 of the Revised Code of Washington, a petition for incorporation as a non-charter code city, signed by qualified voters resident within the limits of the proposed city equal in number to ten percent of the votes cast in the proposed area at the last preceeding general state election has been presented to the Records and Elections Division.

The petition for incorporation states: that the form of government under which the proposed city will operate in the event it is incorporated shall be Council-Manager, sets forth the proposed boundaries of the proposed corporation, states that the name shall be the City of Woodinville and that the number of inhabitants therein as nearly as may be, is 16,350 and prays that it may be incorporated.

The Superintendent of Elections has determined that the petition for incorporation does not violate the prohibitions contained in RCW 35A.03.101 with regard to number of inhabitants and that thee are a sufficient number of valid signatures on the petition.

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.93.100 the Boundary Review Board (BRB) invoked jurisdiction and in accordance with RCW  $\,$ 36.39.160 on January 22, 1988, filed its written decision approving the proposed incorporation as modified which was subsequently appealled.

A final order of King County Superior Court entered on December 15, 1988, dismissed the appeal of the BRB decision and ended the stay against placing the issue on the ballot.

Pursuant to Chapter 29.13.010 and RCW 35.02.078, the council deems an emergency exists for purpose of calling a special election.'

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

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SECTION 1. The King County Bounary Review Board has deemed the matter of an election for incorporation of Woodinville approved as modified as of January 1988.

SECTION 2. The name of the proposed city shall be City of Woodinville.

SECTION 3. The official population of the proposed City of Woodinville, if incorporated, shall be 16,350.

SECTION 4. A special election shall be held on the 14th day of March 1989, within the area of the proposed City of Woodinville, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors the determination of whether it shall be incorporated as a non-charter code city, under the Council-Manager plan of government proposed in the petition.

SECTION 5. The ballot title shall be as directed by statute.

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The boundaries of the proposed City of Woodinville SECTION 6. as modified by the Boundary Review Board are hereby described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the North line of King County, said point being the intersection of the northerly prolongation of the West margin of 130th Avenue NE and the North line of the NE 1/4 Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M.;

Thence Southerly along said Northerly prolongation and the West margin of 130th Avenue NE to the NE corner of lot 4 of the plat of Parkhurst Gardens No. 2 recorded in Volume 101 of plats pages 1 and 2, said plat being corrected in Volume 102 of plats pages 38 through 40, Records of King County, Washington, said NE corner being a point on the existing Bothell city limits according to Ordinance No. 725;

Thence Southwesterly 100 feet along a radial line to the Southerly margin of said Northern Pacific Railway right-of-way and the Bothell city limits according to Ordinance No. 1025;

Thence Southeasterly along said Southerly right-of-way margin and Bothell city limits to a point described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M.;
