- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of portions of S.W. 166th Street (Charles Avenue), herein after described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are to be acquired by Seattle City Light, Water District 75 and Southwest Suburban Sewer District.
- 3. The department of public works recommended for "Denial" of the proposed road vacation. On October 21, 1988, Transportation and Public Utilities Committee reviewed the proposed vacation and recommended the granting of the vacation with modifications.
- 4. The department of public works found some evidence that portions of the vacation area have been opened as a road. However, a search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 6. The petitioner is required to provide the specified utility easements and provide King County with a letter of release from each of the utility companies. The petitioner shall also provide proof that a 28 foot wide private easement is provided for all ownerships along this segment of Southwest 166th Street.
