8834 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Board of Appeals and Equalization and amending policy regarding compensation for board members and hearing examiners; amending Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended and K.C.C. 2.34.050.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6444, Section 5, as amended and K.C.C. 2.34.050 are hereby amended as follows:

Effective January 1, 1989 ((F)) for Compensation. A. ((time)) each six-hour day devoted to official work of the board, each member thereof shall receive a per diem allowance of ((seventy-five-dollars;-provided-that-a-per-diem-allowance-of thirty-five-dollars-shall-be-paid-for-official-work-of-four-hours or-less---Effective-January-l,-1984,-the-per-diem-allowance-shall be-increased-to)) one hundred and twenty-five dollars except that a per diem allowance of ((sixty)) seventy dollars shall be paid for official work of the board of more than four hours ((or)) but less $((\cdot))$ than six hours.

- Effective January 1, 1989 ((F)) for ((time)) each six-hour day devoted to official work of the board, each hearing examiner employed by the board shall receive a per diem allowance of ((ninety)) one hundred and ten dollars; provided, that a per diem allowance of ((fifty-four)) sixty-five dollars shall be paid for official examiner work of more than four hours ((er)) but less $((\cdot))$ than six hours
- C. For time devoted to official work of the board in cases where due to a change in venue, the appeal is heard by members of the board of equalization of another county (the receiving county) as provided for in K.C.C. 2.34.020, each member of the board hearing the appeal shall receive the normal per diem allowance authorized ((by-ordinance-enacted)) by the legislative

authority of the receiving county and a travel allowance based on mileage from the receiving county seat, to the granting county seat, not to exceed mileage rates authorized within the state by general law. D. Members of the board assigned parking stalls shall pay parking fees as provided for in K.C.C. 3.32 unless exempted from payment by ordinance.
