ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to Television Reception District No. 1, King County, Washington, decreasing the number of board members from five to three, amending Ordinance No. 2601, Section 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1425, Section 2, is hereby amended as follows:


There is hereby established a Board of Television Reception Improvement District No. 1, King County, Washington, to be composed of ((five)) three members appointed by the King County council. Each member shall reside within the boundaries of the district. Each member shall serve a three year term except that on the first board one of the members shall be appointed to a one year term and two to two year terms.

A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but the majority vote of the board members shall be necessary for any action taken by the board. The board shall elect from its members a chairman and such other officers as may be necessary. In the event a vacancy occurs prior to the expiration of the member's term, the council shall appoint a person to complete the unexpired term.


