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ORDINANCE NO. 8889

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Oxbow to Val Vue Sewer District.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Oxbow to Val Vue Sewer District was filed with the county council effective February 21, 1989.
- 2. Val Vue Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 86-30 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Val Vue Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated December 29, 1988, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the  $\frac{2040}{100}$  day of  $\frac{100}{100}$ , 19  $\frac{89}{100}$  and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Val Vue Sewer District of the area known as Oxbow and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Oxbow.

SECTION 2. The Val Vue Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.
