I am returning Ordinance No. 8910 to the Council with my signature. In addition, I will be forwarding an ordinance which makes a technical adjustment to Ordinance No. 8910.

Subsequent to the Council's passage of Ordinance No. 8910, the Office of Finance informed us that a full appropriation would be necessary in order for General Services to assume its records and expenditure duties as set forth in the proposed interlocal agreement. The additional appropriation request of \$55,410 is 100% fully revenue backed, and represents the City of Seattle's and the Port of Seattle's contribution toward the Regional Taxicab Commission and Driver Training Program. General Services will be billing the City and Port for their pro-rata contribution which will be deposited in an off-setting revenue account.
