ORDINANCE NO. 8955

AN ORDINANCE making a carryover appropriation of \$5,204,483 from the unexpended balance of funds previously allocated to projects in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, amending Ordinance No. 8802, Section 75, as amended.

PREAMBLE:

King County, in its Ordinance No. 8836, provided for an automated carryover of the prior year's Community Development Block Grant fund budget to May 15 of the subsequent year, but also required the executive to submit a year-end reconciliation of expenditures by April 15. A report of the final year-end reconciliation of expenditures for all projects in Fund 246 has been submitted.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 75, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - From the unexpended balance of funds previously allocated to projects in the Community Development Block Grant Fund, funds are hereby reappropriated to:

\$5,204,48

Provided that:

Of the total of \$5,204,483, the amount of \$4,756,928 is available for the continuation of previously approved projects.

Provided further that:

Of the total of \$5,204,483, the amount of \$447,555 (coded F, G, on the report) is not available for the continuation of previously ap projects, but is reserved for reallocation in the Pass-through Cities Community Development Block Grant Programs and in the County and Sma Cities' 1990 Community Development Block Grant Program.
