AN ORDINANCE establishing a Youth Service Detention Facility Construction Fund to provide for the receipt and disbursement of bond proceeds, and appropriating \$3,986,000 to CIP Project No. 666050 in the Youth Services. Detention Facility Construction Fund (Fund 319), and amending Ordinance No. 8802, Section 92, Attachments 1 and 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a Youth Services

Detention Facility Construction Fund, designated as Fund No.

319. This fund shall be a first tier fund as described in

Chapter 4.10.010 of the King County Code. The director of the department of executive administration shall be the fund manager.

SECTION 2. The purpose of the Fund is to provide for the receipt and disbursement of \$14,238,000 in bond sale proceeds and any interest earned on the sale of bonds authorized by King County voters in November 1988.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$3,986,000 to CIP Project No. 666050 in the Youth Services Detention Facility Construction Fund for costs of demolition, transition, asbestos removal and design of the new DYS detention facility.
