STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Southeast 304th Street, herein after described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements have been granted to Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company and Puget Sound Power and Light Company.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been opened as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls. This recommendation is conditioned upon the finalization of the preliminary Plat of Cobble Creek II, File No. 987-22.
