AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Firlands Way V-2012 Petitioners: Marion Malsch and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Firlands Way, herein after described.
- 2. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were granted to Seattle City Light and General Telephone Company.
- 4. Firlands Way is presently a county maintained roadway. There are no transportation plans or projects that would be adversely affected by vacation of this right of way. The dedicated width of the existing roadway is 90 feet. Since this is not a designated arterial, there appears to be no reason to retain more than a 60 foot right-of-way. Vacation of 15 feet, as requested by this case, would leave 30 feet on the northwesterly half of the street, consistent with retention of a 60 foot dedication. Therefore, the department of public works recommends the vacation be granted.
- 5. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 6. In accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, as amended by Ordinance 3088, the vacation area is classified "Class B". King County is in receipt of a check in the amount of \$3,500 from the petitioners. This amount was determined by multiplying the area by the assessed value per square foot of the adjoining land. Due to encumbrances on the property by the utility companies, the value of the property was reduced by 30% (2,550 sq. ft. x \$1.96 per sq. ft. = \$5,000 less 30%= \$3,500).

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of

King County to grant said petition.
