AN ORDINANCE creating King County Road Improvement District No. 115 and ordering the conversion of a portion of overhead electric and communication facilities to underground facilities under and along certain streets in the Redondo Beach vicinity and authorizing interim financing and the issuance of bonds.

ment district to improve certain streets. Notice of said hearing was duly published and was duly mailed to each property owner pursuant to the requirements of RCW 36.88.050. A diagram showing the lots specially benefited by the project and the estimated cost and expense to be borne by each lot or building site was considered by the council. All written and verbal protests were considered. It is hereby found that the said petitions, including all additions thereto and withdrawals therefrom made prior to 4:30 o'clock p.m. of the business day before the hearing, are sufficient. It is further found that all requirements of RCW 36.88.020, 36.88.050, 36.88.060, 36.88.410, and King County Motion No. 7539 have been satisfied.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: There is hereby established, pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 115" (hereinafter "RID 115"). Said district shall include all the territory within the boundaries described as follows:

> Beginning at a meander corner located north 2037.92 feet from the west quarter corner Section 5, Township 21 north, Range 4 east, W.M.; thence northeasterly along the westerly right-of-way margin of Redondo Beach Road to a point of intersection with the centerline of South 287th Street; thence southeasterly along said centerline 320 feet; thence southwesterly 30 feet to the southeast corner of lot 16 block 3 Redondo Beach Division No. 1; thence southwesterly to the southwest corner of lot 17 block 3; thence southeasterly to the northeast corner of lot 3 block 3; thence southwesterly along the southeasterly boundary of that portion vacated by King county

ordinance 7473 to the southeasterly margin of right-ofway of Fifth Place South; thence westerly to the southwest corner of lot 3 block 2 Redondo Beach Division No. 1; thence westerly along the southeasterly boundary of block 2 to a point of intersection with the westerly boundary of Redondo Beach Division No. 1; thence N 13° 41' 30" W along said western boundary to a point on the boundary line 148.60 feet south of the intersection of said boundary and the centerline of Redondo Beach Road; thence S 57° 16' 54" W 266 feet more or less to the north line of said section 5; thence S 89° 31' 38" W along said section line 149.43 feet more or less to the northeast corner of lot 16 plat of Del Ray Park unrecorded; thence southwesterly along the southeasterly boundary of lots 16 and 15 to the easterly margin of Del Ray Park Drive; thence southerly and northerly along said margin to the southeast corner of lot 5 Del Ray Park; thence southwesterly along the south boundary of said lot 5 to the easterly margin of right-of-way of First Avenue South; thence northerly to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The following described street, which is wholly within RID 115, shall be improved by converting overhead electric and communication facilities to underground facilities and such other work as may be incidental thereto, in accordance with the request on the petition (which improvements are hereinbefore and hereinafter referred to as the "project"):

Redondo Beach Drive from First Avenue South to South 287th Place South; 287th Place from Redondo Beach Drive to Sound View Drive; Sound View Drive (aka Fourth Place South) from South 287th Place to South 287th Street.

SECTION 3: The costs and expenses of the project are estimated to be \$204,667.96. One hundred (100) percent of the actual costs and expenses will be borne by and assessed against the property within the boundary of RID 115. The actual amount of said costs and expense will be determined after the project has been completed.

The amount of actual cost and expenses to be assessed against the properties within the boundary of RID 115 shall be assessed on a proportionate per lot basis. The proportion of assessment to each lot is defined as follows and in Attachment A:

> 51.5% of the total cost and expenses shall be assessed equally to parcels 1 through 25;

19.25% of the total cost and expenses shall be assessed equally to parcels 26 through 40;

29.25% of the total cost and expenses shall be assessed equally to parcels 41 through 51.

The actual amount of the final assessment against each parcel of property within RID 115 shall include the actual total of such costs and expenses incurred in completing the project and shall become a lien against each such parcel of land within RID 115, upon confirmation of the assessment roll by the council. The assessments may be paid in full within 30 days following confirmation of the final assessment roll or, at the option of the owner thereof, in twenty (20) annual and consecutive installments, together with interest on the diminishing principal at a rate which is one-half (1/2)of one percent (1%) higher than the net effective interest rate on the bonds which will be sold to pay the cost of the improvements within RID 115, per annum plus a penalty of ten percent on the principal amount of any delinquent installment plus ten percent of all the then accrued and unpaid interest on the principal balance of the assessment. The amount of the final assessment, together with interest and provisions for penalty, shall, upon confirmation of the assessment roll by the council, become a lien upon each lot or building site within RID 115 from the time said assessment roll is

placed in the hands of the office of finance for collection.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found that the plan for improvement or construction in RID 115 is feasible and that the benefits to be derived therefrom by the property within said district exceed the cost and expense of the formation of said district and the contemplated construction or improvement therein.

SECTION 5: The director of the department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to contract with the necessary parties for the design and construction of the project. When the project has been completed and all the costs and expenses are known or can be predicted with reasonable accuracy, said director is further authorized and directed to prepare and file with the clerk of the King County council a final assessment roll setting forth that portion of the total costs and expenses of the project to be assessed against all the property within RID 115 and the amount to be assessed against each parcel.

SECTION 6: There is hereby created on the books of the King County office of financial management two funds of the county, to be designated as the "King County Road Improvement District No. 115 Construction Fund" and the King County Road Improvement District No. 115 Bond Fund," respectively.

All moneys collected by the office of financial management upon any assessment levied on property within RID 115 for the completion of the project during the thirty-day period allowed for payment of such assessment without penalty or interest, shall be placed in the said construction fund and all such moneys collected thereafter shall be placed in the said bond fund. Moneys in said construction fund shall be used for no other purpose than the payment of costs and expenses of accomplishing the project and the payment of the principal of or interest on interim financing drawn upon or issued against said construction fund. Moneys in said bond fund shall be used solely to pay principal, redemption premium, if any, and interest on the bonds described in the following section.

SECTION 7: The King County office of financial management is hereby

authorized and directed to obtain interim financing for King County Road Improvement District No. 115 construction fund to pay costs and expenses of accomplishing the project pending the repayment or redemption of said interim financing with bonds issued for such purpose, as specified in RCW 36.88.330 or by interfund loan.

Following confirmation of the assessment roll by the council and expiration of the thirty-day period for payment of assessments without penalty or interest, the council will authorize the issuance of bonds sufficient in amount to redeem all the then outstanding interim financing drawn or issued against the RID 115 construction fund and to pay all other unpaid costs and expenses of accomplishing the project.

SECTION 8: "Costs and expenses of accomplishing the project," as used herein and in any subsequent ordinance relating to RID 115, shall mean those costs and expenses described in RCW 36.88.300, as follows: (1) The cost of all of the construction or improvement authorized in RID 115, including that portion of the construction or improvement within the limits of any street or road intersection, space, or spaces; (2) the costs and expenses of all engineering and surveying necessary to be done by the county engineer or under his direction or by such other engineer as may be employed by the King County council; (3) the cost of all advertising, mailing, and publishing of all notices; and (4) the cost of legal service and any other expenses incurred by King County for RID 115 or in the formation thereof, or by said

district in connection with such construction of improvement and in the financing thereof, including the issuance of interim financing and bonds.
