ORDINANCE NO. **9051**

AN ORDINANCE relating to handicap access to arts programs and activities, directing that all arts organizations funded by the King County Arts Commission be in compliance with Section 504 of the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The council seeks to ensure that all arts organizations receiving funding from the King County Arts Commission are in compliance with Section 504 requirements of the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended. Section 504, as amended, prohibits the exclusion of qualified handicapped persons from access to or participation in any program or activity which receives or benefits from federal financial assistance.

SECTION 2. Standards for Arts Allocations. All future allocations by the King County Arts Commission to all arts organizations on annual budgets of over \$1 million shall be contingent upon their being in compliance with the requirements of Section 504, as amended. All allocations by the King County Arts Commission subsequent to January 1, 1990 to arts organizations on annual budgets of under \$1 million shall be

1 contingent upon the organization's contractually agreeing to
2 submit a plan by September 1, 1990, for compliance with the
3 requirements of Section 504, as amended. Those plans must
4 provide for compliance by September 1, 1991.
