ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of HIGH PARK, designated Building and Land Development File No. 209-87-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the May 17, 1989 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on June 1, 1989 on the application of High Park to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. 209-87-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from GR 2.5-P to SR-P for Park Tract "XA", subject to conditions; to RM 2400-P for Divisions RM-I, RM-IIA and RM-IIB (Tracts "AY", "AZ" and "BB" respectively) subject to conditions; to RM 2400-P,

BN-P and SR-P for Division BN-III (Tract "BF") subject to conditions; to RM 2400-P for Division BN-IV (Tract "BG") subject to conditions; to RM 900-P for Division BN-V (Tract "BH") subject to conditions; to BN-P for Division BC-I (Tract "BD") subject to conditions; and to SR-P for Division V-B subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
