AN ORDINANCE relating to the partial transfer of an area known as Des Moines Sewer District/Marine View Drive to Federal Way Water and Sewer District for sewer service.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the partial transfer of an area known as Des Moines Sewer District/Marine View Drive to Federal Way Water and Sewer District for sewer service was filed with the county council effective June 20, 1989.
- 2. Federal Way Water and Sewer District has found the petition for partial transfer to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 88-263 concurred with the proposed partial transfer.
- Federal Way Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated May 25, 1989, on the proposed partial transfer.
- The county council held a public hearing on the 3/5/ day , 19 89 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.32.160.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The partial transfer of Federal Way Water and Sewer District of the area known as Des Moines Sewer District/Marine View Drive, for sewer service and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed partial transfer is consistent with R.C.W. 56.32.160 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Des Moines Sewer District/Marine View Drive.

SECTION 2. The Federal Way Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be partially annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this partial transfer does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this partial transfer area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan. The part of the area known as Des Moines Sewer SECTION 4. District/Marine View Drive to be transferred for sewer service is described as follows: That portion of Government Lot 2, Section 29, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., lying Northerly of the South 240 feet thereof, lying Westerly of the centerline of Puget Sound Marine View Drive (Secondary State Highway No. 1-V) and lying Easterly of a line which is 150 feet Westerly of and parallel with the Westerly margin of said Puget Sound Marine View Drive. .12 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 24^{+1} day PASSED this 3/5t day of KING COUNTY COUNCIL KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON ATTEST: APPROVED this 11 day of Dugust 19 89 King County Executive
