

ORDINANCE NO. **9100**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$406,818 from the Washington State Department of Community Development to the Department of Human Resources to administer the Community Mobilization Against Substance Abuse Project on behalf of the Human Services Roundtable and amending Ordinance 8802, Section 51, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$406,818 from the Washington State department of community development to the department of human resources to support the community mobilization against substance abuse project.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 51, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

DHR ADMINISTRATION From the Washington State department of community development there is hereby appropriated to

DHR Administration \$406,818

SECTION 3. As the lead agency on behalf of King County and the membership of the Human Services Roundtable, the department of human resources shall be responsible to:

A. exercise administrative authority to receive and disburse funds necessary for the implementation of the community mobilization project;

B. assure that all appropriate federal and state laws and regulations are followed in the administration of community mobilization funds and related activities;

C. sign contracts with service providers for local initiatives as specified in grant applications;

D. fill all vacant positions in the Mobilization staff;

E. consult with the steering committee on appointments to professional positions; and

F. hire the community mobilization project director.

SECTION 4. The department of human resources and King County's members on the Human Services Roundtable are instructed to work with the community mobilization project and the Roundtable to develop a work program which enhances rather than duplicates existing community efforts against substance abuse.

The project shall:

A. identify and assist existing, grass roots community groups which are already organized to fight substance abuse;


B. identify communities which have not been mobilized and assist them;

C. develop regular means of coordination between community groups.
