AN ORDINANCE concurring with and modifying the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to DENY the appeal for farm and agricultural designation petitioned by EWING STRINGFELLOW, designated Assessor's Account Nos. 102308-9003-1 and 102308-9239-1, and rejecting the said application as legally insufficient.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates findings nos. 1-4 and 6 of the April 21, 1989 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on May 11, 1989 to deny the appeal for farm and agricultural designation petitioned by Ewing Stringfellow, designated assessor's account nos. 102308-9003-1 and 102308-9239-1, and further finds and concludes, based on the facts presented in the examiner's report and advice of the prosecuting attorney, that Mr. Stringfellow was not the owner of the property during 1988 and therefore there was not a valid application, and requests the department of assessments to consider an application without the 365 day limitation which would apply if a valid application has been denied.
