ORDINANCE NO. **9152**

AN ORDINANCE disapproving an amendment to
Water District No. 90 (annexation 89-1).

PREAMBLE:

On April 4, 1989, the Board of Commissioners of King County
Water District No. 90 adopted Resolution No. 537, adopting an
environmental impact statement as to the annexation of a
certain area known as Annexation 89-1.

On April 24, 1989, the District made a determination of
non-significance for the proposed amendment connected with
the annexation.

On July 18, 1989, the Utilities Technical Review Committee
considered the proposed amendment and recommended
disapproval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District No. 90 Comprehensive Water
Plan Amendment is hereby disapproved. The area addressed in
proposed Annexation 89-1 is designated Rural in the King County
Comprehensive Plan and, as such, is not eligible to receive water
service from a utility district. Furthermore, the Tahoma/Raven
Heights Communities Plan prohibits areas located therein from
receiving water service from water districts or municipalities.
